Prepare for Worship

In order to preserve a sense of reverence in the worship space, please take a moment to silence your electronic devices. Hymns and service music (indicated with an "S" in front of the number) may be found in *The Hymnal 1982*. The lessons from Scripture appointed for the day are located in your Scripture Sheet insert. Children are always welcome in worship at St. Catherine's. However, if your child would be more comfortable outside of the service, childcare is available in our nursery next door.

If you would like to learn more about baptism or about following Jesus in the Episcopal tradition, please speak with the priest at the end of the service. If walking or standing is difficult for you, please remain seated, and we will be happy to bring Communion to you in your pew. Simply let the ushers know as they pass by your pew, and they will notify the priest.
